"Our diocesan schools truly have a commitment to academic excellence and faith formation," said Dr. Erin Barisano, Diocese of Orange superintendent of Catholic schools. "Our students have been learning and succeeding academically while infusing everything with our Catholic identity," she said. "Now we are at a point where we are continuing to build on that as technology changes all the time," Barisano said. "We want to utilize it as a tool for student learning and for evangelization." Since 1974, National Catholic Schools Week has been recognized by every diocese throughout the country. The last Sunday of January marks the beginning of the week. During this time, the Diocese of Orange celebrates the value of Catholic education through a variety of activities and events that include students, their parents, and the community.
