Short Safety Plan – Items to take or put in a safe place checklist:

- *Identification*
- *Immunization records*
- *School and medical records*
- *Keys - house/car/office*
- *Medications*
- *Welfare identification*
- *Divorce papers*
- *Mortgage payment book, current bills*
- *Address book*
- *Children's favorite toys and/or blankets*
- *Birth certificates for my children and me*
- *Social Security cards*
- *Money, bankbooks, credit cards*
- *Change of clothes*
- *Passports, green card, work permit*
- *Lease/rental agreement, house deed*
- *Insurance papers*
- *Pictures, jewelry, items of sentimental value*
