PRIMARY PURPOSE:

The Hospitality Facilitator role will assist in event oversight is involved in setting up and tearing down the equipment necessary to meet the needs of the events being reserved and scheduled on Christ Cathedral Campus and assist in event oversight. Must assure the timely set up in advance of events and teardown following completion. Events range from concerts; banquets; small group meetings; private parties and extensive public gatherings.

DUTIES:

1. Assist in event management/oversight, which will occur primarily on evenings and Saturdays.
2. Provide set up for activities on campus are completed in a timely manner and per prescribed requirements.
3. Assure all furniture and audio visual equipment as ordered is set up and working properly
4. Assure Campus facility policy, standards & requirements are met
5. Assure effective hospitality and outreach is of the upmost professional standard.
6. Assist in event management including but not limited to: equipment set up, and occasional program oversight, which includes some evenings and weekends.
7. Ensure event contract obligations are met with required equipment
8. Assist in facilities reservations, catering services, set ups, and material preparation for events, meetings, workshops and classes.
9. Perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Hospitality.
