



# MISSIONARY IMAGE OF Our Lady *of* Guadalupe

## *Visiting the Diocese of Orange!*

**November 1 – November 24, 2024**

Starting November 1, the Roman Catholic Diocese of Orange will host a tour of the Missionary Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, a symbol of deep significance for the Catholic faithful. This Church-authorized digital image of the original 1531 tilma, housed at the Basilica Shrine in Mexico City, holds an official Catholic Church title, mission, and certification. It has been linked to miraculous phenomena, such as a heartbeat heard where the Virgin Mary carries Christ and reports of oil dripping from the image.

Saint Pope John Paul II entrusted the New Evangelization to Our Lady of Guadalupe, asking her to visit every diocese, parish, and family in America. The Diocese of Orange hopes that veneration of this image will inspire a new era of evangelization, encourage Catholic conversion, and promote a culture of life and love.


