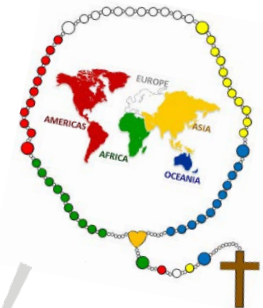


**Dime, Nickel, Penny, or Quarter Race**
